

Reassessment guidelines for Algebra I

- 1) All quizzes and other formative grade are not eligible for retesting.
- 2) All projects and final exams are not eligible.
- 3) Most summative grades (tests) are eligible.
- 4) Students can only retest once per semester.
- 5) Students can only retest if:
 - a. Sign up in the retesting log.
 - b. Completed all of their assignments in a timely manner BEFORE the test. No more than a 3/5 on each homework assignment.
 - c. Fill out a test grade reflection sheet.
 - d. Appropriate corrections must be completed on a separate sheet of paper. The problem must be rewritten and all work must be readable. Also required is a sentence explaining what the student did wrong and what the student can do to not make the mistake again.
 - e. A guardian signature is required on the test grade reflection sheet
 - f. Staple the reflection sheet with the original test
- 6) The reassessment date will be offered only one day. Students can either retest during lunch or one day before or after school.
 - a. Students may bring their lunch to the room.
 - b. Students must show up by 7:15am if a date is offered in the mornings or by 3:55pm in the afternoon. No students will be admitted after that time.
- 7) The reassessment will not be in the same format as the original test and maybe more demanding.
- 8) The original grade and their test grade will be averaged together. The maximum grade is 80%.
